So what is roofline?

Roofline is the collective name for the point where the outer walls of your house meet the roof.

The **Fascia** is the board which supports the bottom row of roof tiles and often carries the guttering.

The **Bargeboard** is normally on the gable of the house and supports the tile edge but carries no guttering.

The **Soffit board** is the neat and tidy board which covers the roofing rafters and adjoins the fascia board and brickwork.

The **Box End** is the intricate adjoining of all three boards tailor-made to suit the individual angles of the roof.

How does it compare to timber?

The roofline is one of the most vulnerable parts of any building especially where timber is concerned and, perhaps surprisingly, most people's homes have quite extensive woodwork fitted to its exterior.

More often than not, this can be low grade timber too, which is particularly prone to rot and decay if important and frequent maintenance is neglected.

The maintenance cycle can be expensive, time consuming and often disruptive.

Replacing your roofline products with Cellular PVCu is an attractive alternative to timber, eliminating this costly repetitive maintenance.



What is Cellular PVCu

Cellular PVCu is an extruded foam filled material with a smooth durable outer skin.

The product can be cut, drilled, nailed and machined in a similar manner to timber but is light to handle and does not require painting after installation.

When it comes to replacing your soffits and fascias, choosing a good looking roofline product is only part of the story.

Expert installation of the product is vital too, to protect your home from damp.

Unlike some installers, we only carry out the full replacement of the existing fascia boards and use expert teams of installers with specialist scaffolding systems.

Our permanently venting eaves guard protector allows your roof timbers to breathe and therefore reduces the likelihood of future damp problems.

The integrated bird guard helps prevent the nesting of birds and larger insects in the roof area.

A dry verge system is available for properties where a modern roof tile has been utilised and this is an option to avoid any unsightly mortar finishes to the gables.
